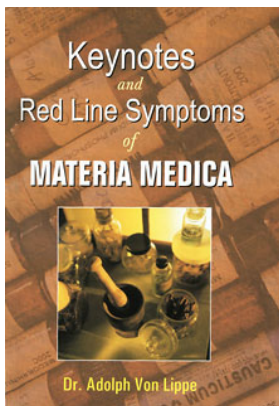

Abrotanum.

COMMON NAME : SOUTHERN WOOD.

Marasmus of children, with marked emaciation, especially of legs (*Iod., Sanic, Tub.* emaciation of neck—*Nat-M., Sanic*). The skin is flabby and hangs loose in folds (À.).

The child is cross and depressed (G.).

RAVENOUS* HUNGER ; LOSING FLESH WHILE EATING WELL (*Iod., Nat-M., Sanic, Tub.*) (A.).

Alternats diarrhœa ana rheumatism (metastatic . rheumatism) (N.).

Alterne te constipation and diarrhœa -, Henteria (*Aloe, Nux-V., Podo., Sulph.*) (A.).

Epistaxis, hydrocele or emaciation of Utile, boys (G.).

Nuttib, weak, tremulous and paretic (B.).

MARASMUS OF LOWER EXTREMITIES ONLY (*Amm-M., Atg-N.*) (A.).

Rheumatism of beart (K.)-

Nightly backache (B.).

Child is ill-natureâ, irritable, cross and despondent ; violent, inhuman, would like to do something cruel (A.).

BLOATBD ABDOMEN (B.).

Face old, pale, wrinkled (*Arg-N., Lyc, Op.*) (A.).

Darting or twitching in either or both ovaries (G.).

In marasmus, head weak, cannot hold it up (iEth.).

Cutting pains in stomach, gnawing, bnrning (G.).

Painful contractions of the limbs from cramps or following colic (A.).

Vomits much offensive fluid (B.).

Rheumatism •.for the excessive pain before the swelling commences ; from suddenly checked diarrhoea or other secretions ; alternates with hæmorrhoids, with dysentery (A.).

Great weakness and prostration after influenza (G.).

Gout : joints stiff, swollen, with pricking sensation ; wrists and ankle-joints painful and inflamed (A.).

Very lame and sore all over (*Am., Rapt., Pyrog., Rhus-T.*) (A.).

Blood and moisture oozing from the navel of new-born children (G.).

Itching chilblains (*Agar.*) (A.X)

Distended veins on forehead (B.).

Great weakifess and prostration and a kind of hectic fever with children ; unable to stand (A.).

AGGRAVATION : In cold air or from getting wet ; from checked secretions ; in fogs ; during night.

AMELIORATION : From loose stool ; from motion.

BELATIONSHIP : After *Hepar* in furuncle ; after *Aeon*, and *Bry.* is pleurisy, when a pressing sensation remains in affected side impeding respiration.

Aconitum Napellus,

COMMON NAME : MONK'S HOOP.

Is generally indicated in acute or recent cases occurring in young persons, especially girls of a full, plethoric habit, who lead a sedentary life ; persons easily affected by atmospheric changes ; dark hair and eyes, rigid muscular fibres (A.).

THE PAIN IS INSUPPORTABLE, LEADING TO DESPAIR (*CoffJ.*)

THE PATIENT IS FULL OF FEARS, AND TOSSES ABOUT, AS IF IN AGONY (*Ars.*),

RESTLESSNESS AND INCONSOLABLE ANXIETY.

IS AFRAID TO GO OUT, TO GO INTO A CROWD, WHERE THERE IS ANY EXCITEMENT OR MANY PEOPLE ; TO CROSS THE STREET (A.).

SUDDEN AND GREAT SINKING OF STRENGTH (*Ars., Camph., Hydro-Ac.*)

Sensation of soreness of the body, and of heaviness in inner parts.

Tearing in outer parts (*Rhus.*).

Tingling in the fingers, oesophagus and back (Sec).

Painfulness of the whole body to contact (he does not wish to be touched) (*Am.*).

Pulsating pain in the head and teeth (Bell).

Inflammation of inner parts (mucous membranes).

Stitches in internal organs. (*Apis., Bry., Rali-C, Sittph.*)

Tightness of the muscles (acute rheumatism).

THE MOST VALUABLE FEBRIFUGE IN THE ENTIRE RANGE OF THERAPEUTIC AGENTS.

PULSE FULL AND HARD, OR IMPERCEPTIBLE.

DRY, BURNING SKIN.

HEAT, WITH INCLINATION TO UNCOVER ONESELF (*Sulph.*).

MILIARIA LIKE THE ERUPTION OF MEASLES (*Bry., Puis.*).

WHEN RISING PALENESS OF THE FACE.

PRODUCES AND CURES DRENCHING SWEATS (*Chin.*).

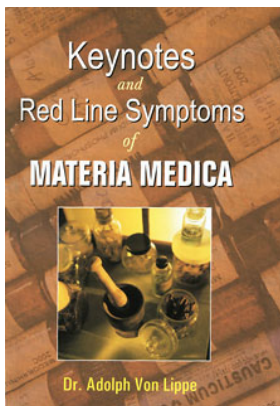
Bad effects from catching cold, from anger, or from fright, especially with females during menstruation.

Most symptoms disappear while sitting quietly, but at night and in bed they are insupportable.

Cough, croup; dry, noarse, suffocating; loud, rough, croaking; hard, ringing, whistling; on expiration (*Caust. ,•* on inhalation—*Spong.*); from dry, cold winds, or drafts of air (*A.*).

RETENTION OF URINE IN NEW BORN INFANTS (*Apis, Ars., Camph., Caust., Lye, Puls.*) (*K.*).

DYSENTERY: WHEN THE DAYS ARE WARM AND THE NIGHTS ARE COOL; SCANTY, LOOSE,
