

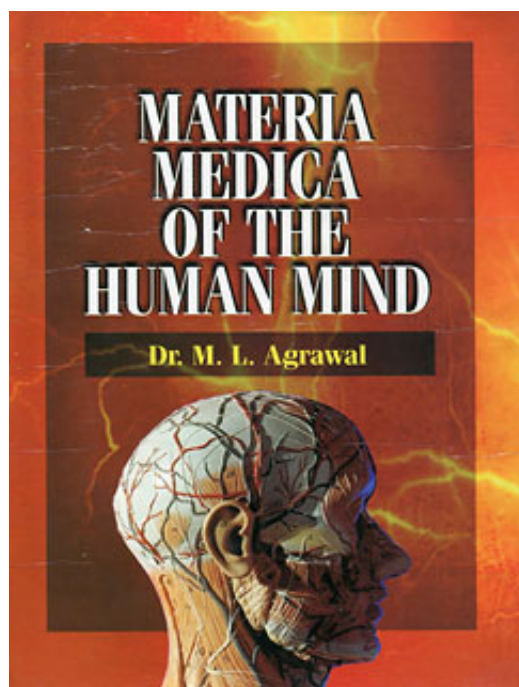

# *Foreword*

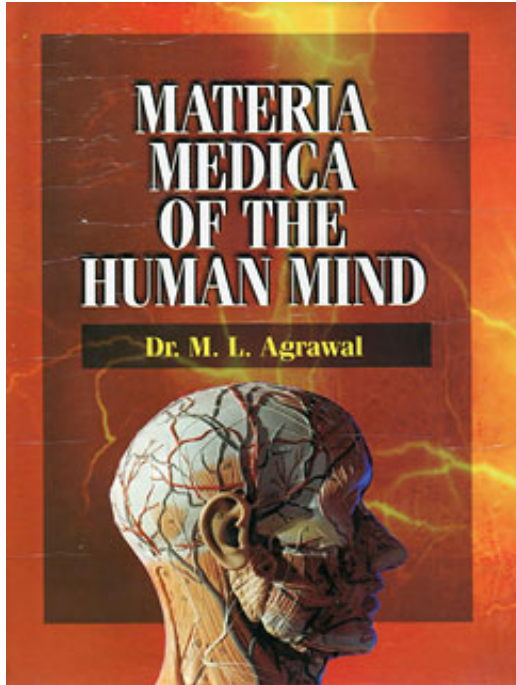

He does not lay any claim to originality in bringing out this work but truly asserts that it can be useful to the profession for the purpose of individualisation of a remedy, for verification and confirmation.

I do agree with him as this compilation gives us, at a glance, the mentals of a drug, all of which cannot be located in one single source. One should also add to it suitably documented and confirmed mental Symptoms from clinical experience.

Dr. Agrawal seems to be a zealous worker for the development of Homoeopathy and such a spirit of involvement will be appreciated by the profession. This book, I am sure, will find a suitable place in the libraries of the teaching institutions and of the individual practitioners. I wish that the type of the "Single Symptoms" and so called "Common Symptoms" should have been more prominent or distinctive for the purpose of differentiation. By "Single Symptoms" the author means that this symptom is not found in any other drug and by "Common Symptoms", he means that these Symptoms are present in other drug or drugs also. This word "Common" should not be confused with "Common Symptoms" as defined by Kent.
