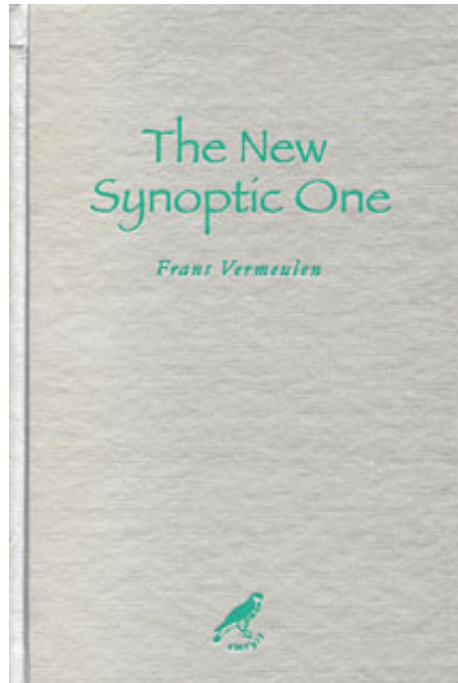

NUCLEUS

1. Dreamy, confused, drowsy.
2. Overpowering sleepiness.
3. < During pregnancy [mental and physical affections; complete change of j personality].
4. Chilliness.
5. Sensation of extreme dryness of mouth and throat, yet no thirst.
6. Tremendous bloating and constipation.

FAMILY: Myristicaceae [superorder: *Magnoliidae*].

SENSATIONS: Strange. Confusion. Bewildered. Lost. Collapsed. Fainting. Floating. Sleepy. Stupefied. Living in own world. Withdrawn into own familiar world and shutting out the strange outer reality. Penetrating.

FAMILY: Loganiaceae.

AFFINITY

MIND. Cerebro-spinal axis. **NERVES.** **DIGESTIVE ORGANS** [STOMACH; LIVER; *bowels*]. **RESPIRATORY ORGANS.** Dark haired males. * **RIGHT SIDE.**
Left side.

MODALITIES

Worse: EARLY MORNING [4 a.m.]. COLD [OPEN AIR [dry]; *drafts*; seats; wind; UNCOVERING]. HIGH LIVING [COFFEE; condiments; liquor; drugs; *debauchery*; *purgatives*]. *Sedentary habits*. Overeating. *Mental [exertion; fatigue; vexation]*. Disturbed sleep. SLIGHT CAUSES [*anger; noise; odours*; [light; *touch*; PRESSURE [of clothes, < waist]. \Better: FREE DISCHARGES. Naps. *Wrapping head*. Rest. Hot drinks. *Milk*. *Moist air*. In evening. Warm room. Covering. After stool. Flatus. Warmth. Loosening the garments.

MAIN SYMPTOMS

M STRONG inner URGE [to achieve; to have it his own way].

Aversion to RESTRICTIONS. M AMBITIOUS [wants to be the best; often two jobs].

Ailments from *disappointed ambition*.

RULED by their GOAL.

FANATIC [zealous]; COMPETITIVE.

CRAMPED STATE; can't relax.

M INDEPENDENT [fear of marriage; fear of intimacy]. M FASTIDIOUS.

FAULT-FINDING.

REPROACHING OTHERS. M

IRRITABLE [may be hidden inside].

IMPATIENT [hate to wait in queues; driving in traffic with cursing, hooting etc.].

Time URGES [don't want to waste time]. M

OVERSENSITIVE to all EXTERNAL IMPRESSIONS. [ft!

QUARRELSOME, even to VIOLENCE. M IEALOUS.

& Abusiveness. G

Very CHILLY.

< Open air.

< Cold in general.

G Craving for STIMULANTS [coffee, wine, hot spices, cigarettes].

Needs COFFEE to work, and ALCOHOL to sleep. G

WAKING at 3-4 A.M. with activity of mind, rush of ideas. G

Characteristic SLEEP:

- "Goes to sleep and wakes about 3 very uncomfortable. Often lies awake then, thinking and worrying and drops off when nearly time to get up. When they wake again feel rotten - headachy - horrible taste - uncomfortable in chest or tummy."²

Very IRRITABLE on WAKING. Ailments from LOSS of SLEEP.

G High SEX DRIVE. G <

Lying on the BACK.

> Lying on either SIDE.

G < MOTION.

> While SITTING.

G < TIGHT clothing [aversion to restrictions].

G > FREE DISCHARGES. G > HEAT.

[pains stomach, bladder, abdomen]. G

INEFFECTUAL URGING

to stool [constipation], to urinate [cystitis], to belch, to sneeze, to vomit. I

Sensation as if NOT FINISHED [as in their work].

Pains [head, stomach, abdomen, back, parturition] & urging for stool.

G CRAMPS. CRAMPED STATE. SPASMS.

Jerks. Twisting. Tensed feeling. G Indolence

[mental and physical] after MEALS.

RUBRICS

MIND: Loss of *ambition* from disappointment. *Anger*, when obliged to answer, from interruption. *Buoyancy* alternating with sadness. *Delusions*, someone gets into his bed and there is no more room, body inside is made of threads, sees mutilated bodies, people carry on all sorts of prank with him [Hydrog.], people address him with questions and he must answer. *Fear* of opinion of others. Abundant *ideas* in evening in bed. *Intolerance* of his complaints. Sudden impulse to *kill* for a slight offence. *Libertinism*. *Loquacity* about his health. *Reproaches* others, during pains. *Sensitive* to noise, slightest, of stepping, voices. Flow of *thoughts* in morning after rising.

VERTIGO: From being in a room with many *lights*. From *odour* of flowers.

HEAD: Sensation of *looseness of brain* in hot weather. *Pulsating*, vertex, from fixing attention, from mental exertion.

VISION: *Blurred*, when overheated. *Glittering* objects outside the range of vision, on blowing nose.

STOMACH: *Heartburn*, in morning before breakfast, after acids. *Indigestion*, after abuse of drugs, after coffee, after mental exertion. *Pain*, cramping, causing urging to stool.

RECTUM: *Constipation*, after abuse of drugs, from sedentary habits. *Diarrhoea*, from draft of air, after cathartics, after ginger.

FEMALE: *Pain*, bearing down, uterus, with urging to stool.

BACK: *Pain*, night, after 4 a.m. driving him out of bed, turning, must sit up to turn over in bed, > external warmth; sacral region, with urging to stool; as if broken, before stool.

SLEEP: *Sleeplessness* after abuse of wine.

DREAMS: *Business*.

FOOD

AVOTZOM: [3]: Ale; beer; coffee; food; meat; tobacco; water. [2]: Bread; food, after eating a little; smoking; tobacco, smell of. [1]: Acids; alcoholic stimulants; brown bread; fat; food, sight of; food, smell of; food, thought of; milk; salt; sweets; water, cold; wine.

Desire: [3]: Alcohol; beer; brandy. [2]: Coffee; fat; spicy; lime; milk. [1]: Bitter drinks; bitter food; charcoal; cold drinks; fat + sweets; indigestible things; pepper; smoking; starch; sweets; tea; tobacco; tonics; whisky; wine. *Worse*: [3]: Coffee; cold food; spicy; tobacco; wine. [2]: Beer; bread; cold drinks; milk; smoking; tea; tobacco, smell of. [1]: Black bread; bread and butter; dry food; eggs; farinaceous; fat; hot food; meat; onions; salad salt; sour; veal; vinegar; warm food. *Better*: [3]: Hot food; warm drinks. [2]: Coffee; milk. [1]: Fat.

NUCLEUS

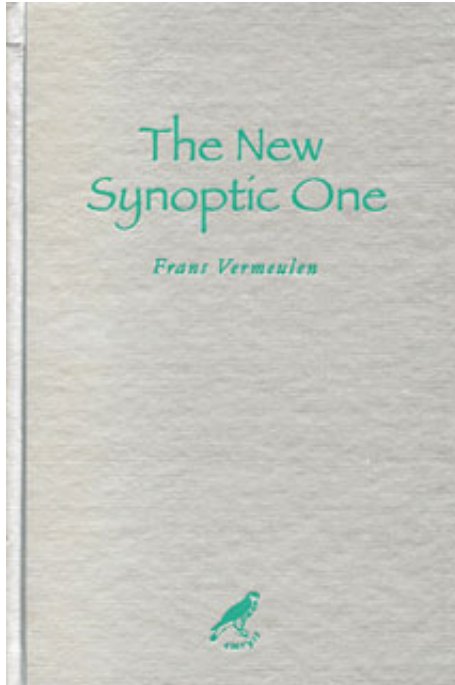
1. Strong urge; ineffectual urging; feeling as if not finished [work, stool, micturition]. Pains & urging for stool.
2. Fastidious, ambitious, irritable, malicious [if opposed], violent.
3. < Early morning [unrefreshed, irritable, depressed, pains].
4. Very chilly. Pains > heat.
5. Craving for stimulants.
6. Cramped states.

FAMILY: *Loganiaceae*.

SENSATIONS: Shocked. Shattered. Torn to pieces. Disappointment. Beside oneself. Excitable. Paralysed. Silent. Grief. Can't weep. Spasms. Composed and calm in the most shocking circumstances.

MIASM: Typhoid.
