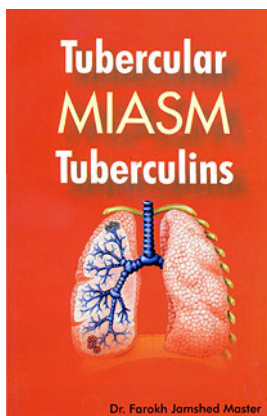

THE SECONDARY SYMPTOMS OF TUBERCULOSIS

MIND

Child of the union of Syphilitic and Psoric dyscrasias presents a picture of the "problem child" slow in comprehension dull, unable to keep a line of thought unsocial - keeps to himself and becomes sullen and morose.

Alternately, cheerfulness optimism and hopefulness especially in terminal states is a strong indication for tubercular state.

A State of changefulness (May even be hysterical): borne out by a constant urge to travel or for a change of locality.

Fair, intelligent, precocious person with increased sexual desire easily forming intense emotional bonds and consequently many physical and mental symptoms arise from a disappointment in love.

The heightened manifestation of psoric phenomena must be considered to be tubercular in nature; for e.g. restlessness is a psoric trait but when this restlessness is so increased as to drive the patient to disturb others and to make a general nuisance of himself, it is considered to be tubercular.

Patient's mental symptoms are better by the outbreak of an ulcer. Many tubercular states are ameliorated by diarrhoea.

EAR AND HEARING:

All organic ear troubles especially affecting the middle ear.

Suppurative process and destruction of the ossicles of the ears.

Ears are often a safety valve in tubercular children. Abscesses relieve quite severe meningeal difficulties. They show up frequently in measles, scarlet fever, etc. Here the tubercular element comes readily to the surface in the form of suppuration of the middle ear. More frequently aroused by fever.

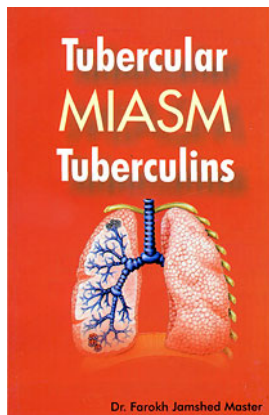
Peculiar, carrion-like odour from these aural abscesses are very characteristic.

Often discharges cheesy or curdled.

Exanthemata - ears.

If free from ear troubles these children invariably suffer from throat affections, especially tonsillitis. They appear well in the day time and free from pain but at night their sufferings begin, and they often scream with ear-ache. They may begin as early as the first year and go on until puberty. The least exposure to cold or slightest draft brings on an attack. Occasionally we have prolonged febrile attacks with great suffering and suddenly better by the breaking of an abscess. Quite often their general health is better even when the ear is discharging copiously, this tubercular, four-smelling pus.

Ears look pale, often cold, and in some cases translucent almost with the blood vessels enlarged, bluish in colour or bright red. (also in Syphilis)
