



DELUSION, SNAKES IN AND AROUND HER

Belladonna

Belladonna patients have great anxiety and fear of imaginary things, want to run away from them. The patient will be sick longer, will go into a greater state of prostration. In *Belladonna* the blood is being hurried to the head. All sorts of delusions and hallucinations are mingled with the acute mania, ghosts, horrid monsters, strange things, hideous faces, black dogs and various insects. He wants to jump out of the window, wants to run, wants to get away from his attendants. He thinks they are doing him injury. Throughout the acute mania and throughout the delirious state, all the manifestations partake of violence. This condition occurs due to surcharge of blood to the brain. When the throbbing of the-carotids, the heat, redness and congestion of face and conjunctiva go away, the delirium subsides in proportion. *Belladonna* may have delirium with pale face as its alternate, but it is the exception. Ever the upper lip is congested and swollen. Strange delusion, illusion and hallucinations with loss of consciousness.

Calcarea carbonicum

The over activity of mind in *Calcarea* takes a peculiar form. He finds no rest because of the same disagreeable

idea, always lingering in his mind, and rousing him as often as he falls into a light slumber. She has delusion of snakes in and around her. He sees horrid visions before his eyes. In his delirium he plays with cats and other animals and talks about fire, mice and murder. Sensation as if something, running in arms, or from pit of stomach down through the abdomen into feet.

The *Calc-c.* patient is full of ideas; when closing the eyes horrible visions. It is very useful in complaints from prolonged worry, from prolonged application to business from excitement. It is full of peculiar kind of mental feeling; he feels his exhaustion of mind, and it seems to him that this weakness and this inability to do and think connectedly, must be going towards insanity, he broods over it.

He imagines things, and the things he imagines you will really wonder at his dwelling upon them so because they are such little things, and so it is when he goes into insanity, or imbecility, or a general break down. He thinks about this matter so much and thinks everybody else is watching him, until finally the instant he closes his eyes he has visions. Thus as soon as he gets down quiet and thinks now I will go to sleep, I will get rid of all this. When he is alone, when he has nobody to talk with him, he does strange things. He is controlled and dominated when he is in company, to a great extent, and hence these things are not brought out. He carries out that same idea when he becomes delirious or insane.

Sees visions and faces of persons when eyes are closed, "Imagines someone is walking beside her."

Mental aberration with horrid visions. Sees dogs crowding around, he fight them off. Here is a sensation occurring in nervous women, "feels as if she would like to run up and down and scream." Feels as if she could not help it, she must scream.

Lac caninum

Fear and anxiety that some horrible disease has come upon her, a delusion that she was suppurating and in a loathsome state, infested with snakes. Horrible sights are presented to the mental vision, not always snakes, and she fears the object will take form and present themselves to her eyes. This is analogues to *Lachesis*, which has the feeling that the atmosphere is full of hovering spirits, although he never sees them.

Lac-c. imagines he wears someone else's nose, she imagines she is not herself and her properties are not her own. Imagines she sees spiders, snakes, vermin. She cannot bear to be alone.

Lachesis


The patient wants to be alone to indulge the strange fancies, and when alone she feels as if she were floating out of the window and over the grassy plains, but a sound

will bring her back to the world again. This is on the borderland of insanity or delirium.

In *Lac-c.* sensitiveness is marked, sensitive to light and noise. The page is not clear when reading. She sees faces before her in the dark, old, troubled, distorted disagreeable faces come to the vision or imagination. Dark hideous faces and she is tormented by them. This is not really a symptom of the vision, but a state of the brain.

In *Lac-c.* is found is a strange delusion about snakes. He imagines as if he is surrounded by snakes. He falls asleep thinking of snakes, during sleep dreams of snakes and wakes up from sleep in fright as if about to be bitten by snakes.

The patient, like the one in acute delirium of this remedy, is liable to alternate between the mild and violent manifestation. The *Hyoscyamus* patient is weak and the weakness increases. His violent outbreaks of delirium cannot keep up long on account of weakness.
