Another important element that is missing in Ferrum is his sense of lying.

When Ferrum decompensates you will find someone that becomes very harsh and stiff.

No energy - Talk about when they could fight

When they don't have the energy anymore and can't fight as much, they keep it alive by always telling what they did when they could fight.

Ferrum is for people who cannot use their war attitude.

Ferrum is a strong person and able to fight but unable to integrate their aggressive side.

It is much more common to see them as a lawyer rather than a fighter because there is a lack of physical power, therefore you will see a much more seductive strategy by using their mind to reach their goal.

Compensated Ferrum punches too much.

Decompensated Ferrum can't fight or integrate their aggressive side.

Healthy Ferrum

Ferrum can't integrate the bloody side or the healthy aggressive side of themselves, but in a healthy state they are able to stand up for themselves and say, "fuck off and leave me alone.

Massimo thoughts

If you think about the evolution of man, the less evolved you are in life and child-like, the more you use your hands to fight; and the more evolved or adult-like you are the more you will use your mind. In the wars of today the most effective way to win the war is to fight by using the mind. You can win a battle if you punch someone but if you are clever enough you can find a good strategy to win without punching.

CUPRUM

Ferrum is the soldier and Cuprum is the general.

You will see how clever they are to choose the right person for the right position. A person like Arnica could not be a general because they need to be kind, compete, and have a great sophisticated strategy in their mind to win the war, which is a natural for Cuprum.

Cuprum know they can't be the warriors and they need to be above the others controlling them.

The more you work with Cuprum the more they can be in touch with their emotions.

You will see in decompensation that Cuprum has the delusion of being of rank.

It is common in Cuprum because of Alchemical metal attitude to do whatever to reach high position. Not every case as to be that powerful as it is just a metaphor, but usually you will see they are never a person under control of someone else.

Cuprum has a feeling of being a peasant, yet have a strong idea they must realize for their king.

CASTRATED

It is symbolic of a kind of castration because without recognition from this "king" they feel they have failed and are a peasant.

Can't integrate male energy - must control others

Cuprum feels they are nothing underneath so they must control others. The deep feeling of not being able to integrate male energy is one of the main problems of Cuprum.

Main anguish of Cuprum is when they are not recognized anymore.

When the king tells them they did a great job they are happy.

They need to hear they did a great job because underneath they feel they don't deserve it. They work really hard to achieve this high position and after they achieve this position they feel they can finally relax.

One of the reasons at the end they just want to become a happy peasant is that they want to adjust their perception.
